The week of the trip:

- If you have not already paid in full, bring a check to Mr. Rugoletti for the week's trip.
- Parents - We consider your signature on the check as consent for the week's trip.
- If you pay in CASH, PLEASE have a separate note from your parent(s)/guardian(s) indicating they give you permission to join us for that week's trip.

On Fridays:

- Skis are dropped off at door 5 (room 320 - near the boiler room) between 6:30 and the start of classes on Friday morning. If you must drop equipment after that, please bring it to the front office.
- At the end of the day, gather your belongings, change if you want, and wait in the cafeteria to board.
- You MAY leave your books, instruments, and backpacks in room 320. We will have access to them at night.
- We board the bus around 2:45, unless we are leaving at noon. In that case, we board at 11:45.
- We will depart no later than 3:00 (or 12:00). The bus will not wait for you!
- If you drive to school, and snow is predicted, you will be asked to park your car near "the fence."
- We will return to TRHS for pickup from Pat's at 11:15. Parents - Please try to pick up your students on time. Our chaperones cannot leave until the last student is safely away!
- YOU NEED TO LET US KNOW IN ADVANCE IF YOU ARE PICKING YOUR CHILD UP AT PAT'S PEAK.
- ONLY PARENTS MAY PICK UP CHILDREN. Parents may only pick up their own children!

The National Ski Patrol Responsibility Code



1. Always stay in control. You must be able to stop or avoid people or objects.
2. People ahead of you have the right-of-way. You must avoid them.
3. Stop only where you are visible from above and do not restrict traffic.
4. Look uphill and avoid others before starting downhill or entering a trail.
5. You must prevent runaway equipment.
6. Read and obey all signs, warnings, and hazard markings.
7. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
8. You must know how and be able to load, ride and unload lifts safely. If you need assistance, ask the lift attendant.
9. Do not use lifts or terrain when impaired by alcohol or drugs.
10. If you are involved in a collision or incident, share your contact information with each other and a ski area employee.

Know the code. It's your responsibility.

This is a partial list. Be safety conscious.
